Items Discussed:

1. **Map 13 Lot 157** - 7 Carlisle Dr., Joan McKibben and Roger St. Laurent agree with the new wetlands delineation. Schedule for the Planning Board's Feb 19, 2008 meeting.
2. **Map 2 Lot 128** – Cutler Road, letter needed to ZBA from LCC. **LCC to state there will be an impact to the forested wetlands.**
3. **Map 15 Lot 6** – one lot into three (owner R. Theroux) Planning Board rescheduled to April 1, 2008 (aquifer district). Meeting w/LCC 3/6/08 then LCC to write a letter, re; Aquifer District.
4. **Map 20 Lot 117 and 119** – Sybil Lane, variance denied, none of the conditions of the variances were met, they will go back to the ZBA for request for re-hearing.
5. **Map 20 Lot 15** – 450 Charles Bancroft Hwy (former Crofters Restaurant Property) aquifer district, proposed site for a laser tag facility, will use existing building, 3,000 SF. LCC to write a letter – Okay by LCC will use less water than a restaurant.

6. Nick Boshears -5 Burgess St. – LCC received an email from the property owner on 1/24/08 voicing his concern at the decline of wild life /aquatic life to the pond behind his house, Mr. Boshears mentions in his letter that whenever the neighboring Aldrich Road is salted, a steady stream of brown/brackish water makes it to the pond behind his house via the stream that runs directly below Aldrich Road. Mr. Boshears was wondering if the wildlife is in the process of being killed off due to the salt being used and goes on to state he would be happy to pay for any sample water tests to compare that wetland water to other wetland waters in the area unaffected by salt use. LCC would like that area to be a ‘NO SALT’ area.
7. **Map 12 Lot 25** – Public Hearing set for 2/14/08 for LCC to purchase.
8. NH Fish and Game Wildlife Action Plan (WAP) and Zoning – Joan McKibben attended 1/29/08. Upcoming WAP, Merrimack NH Monday March 10, 2008. Marion Godzik to attend and possibly Sharon Jones.
9. Fishing Derby Date – May 10, 2008, Sharon & Marion will try and get donations from the local town businesses ie, Hidden Creek, Fur & Feathers. Irwin Marine no longer sells fishing equipment, they have generously donated in the past.
